### Research: Positive outcomes from Stroke Research Showcase 2023

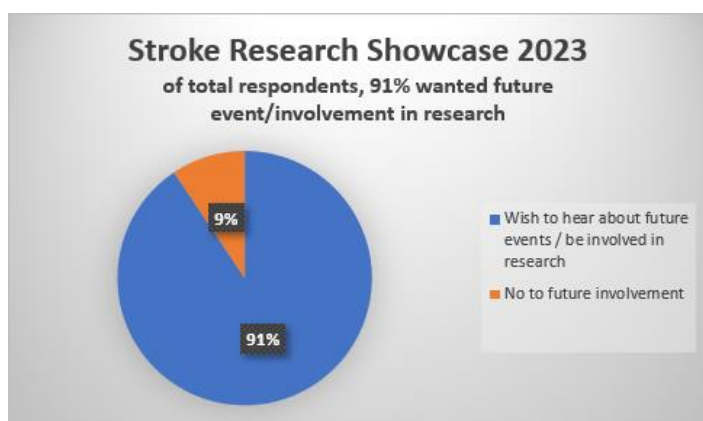
A Stroke Research Showcase event was held on 31st August 2023 at the Clinical Sciences Building, Nottingham City Hospital. This was the first stroke lay conference organised since 2019 prior to the Covid-19 pandemic.

The event proved a resounding success, with the participation of **85 stroke survivors, carers, members of the public and researchers**. The event welcomed presentations covering key topics including electrical stimulation to treat swallowing difficulties, Fatigue after stroke, Psychological Care for TIA and Minor Stroke and Home-based rehabilitation for stroke survivors with severe disability.

The event brought opportunities for participants to hear details of some of the latest stroke research and share their valuable experiences with researchers to help shape future research directions. Feedback from the delegates at the event was positive.
